#### About the Job:

The Director of Expanded Learning leads the expanded learning program team at the Children's Initiative and supports the efforts of the San Diego County After School Consortium. The Director works closely with the San Diego County Office of Education to improve expanded learning programming at the site level, build program and district capacity and to provide grant support and partnerships building. This position, while not working directly with children, is a job that directly supports others who work to improve the lives of children and families.

The Director of Expanded Learning must possess internal motivation and passion and demonstrate integrity, strong work ethic and willingness to learn. The Director of Expanded Learning must have the ability to multi-task with ease, be creative and innovative and have very strong written and verbal skills.

### **Essential Duties and Responsibilities:**

The Director of Expanded Learning will perform a very wide variety of responsibilities working in a cohesive team, including but not limited to:

- Provide leadership and management to the after school team
- Provide direct guidance and professional development to school districts, community based organizations and program staff
- Effectively manage and coordinate multiple grants and contracts simultaneously
- Develop and implement professional development conferences
- Develop and publish the San Diego After School Consortium Annual Report



- Convene and professionally facilitate meetings of the San Diego After School Consortium and District Contacts
- Develop and expand partnerships with school leaders, community partners, government entities and local businesses
- Research, identify and disseminate best practice strategies and emerging approaches for before and after school
- Successfully manage all before and after school related projects
- Oversee application process for new and /or continued funding
- Assist with other projects as needed
