



Test Your Knowledge! Supplement vs. Supplant Activity



U.S. Code, Section 6321(b) and *EC* Section 52852.5(c)

Federal funds should be used to **supplement (build upon or enhance)**, **not supplant (replace or substitute)**, existing state and local fiscal efforts. Schools that receive the funds shall have base expenditures comparable to nonparticipating schools.

Golden State Elementary school currently offers yearbook as a club for students.
