About Nick Schultz:

Nick Schultz was elected to the Burbank City Council in 2020 with the secondhighest vote count in the city's history. During his time as Councilmember and Mayor, he played a pivotal role in advancing the city's greenhouse gas reduction plan toward carbon neutrality, reducing homelessness by 10% through humane policies and lowering crime by 10% while reallocating \$2 million from the police budget to social welfare programs. Elected during the pandemic, Nick championed public health measures, secured PPE for workers and residents, passed "Hero Pay" for frontline grocery workers and supported small businesses with resources and services. A dedicated public servant, Nick serves as a Deputy Attorney General in the California Department of Justice's Special Prosecutions Section where he investigates and prosecutes cases of public corruption, human trafficking, financial fraud and more. He was instrumental in creating the Department's first Post-Conviction Review Unit allowing for the review of claims of innocence and wrongful conviction, giving voice to individuals seeking justice.
